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Colour figure for Chapter 8. The seasonality of using wetland and riparian environments at Çatalhöyük

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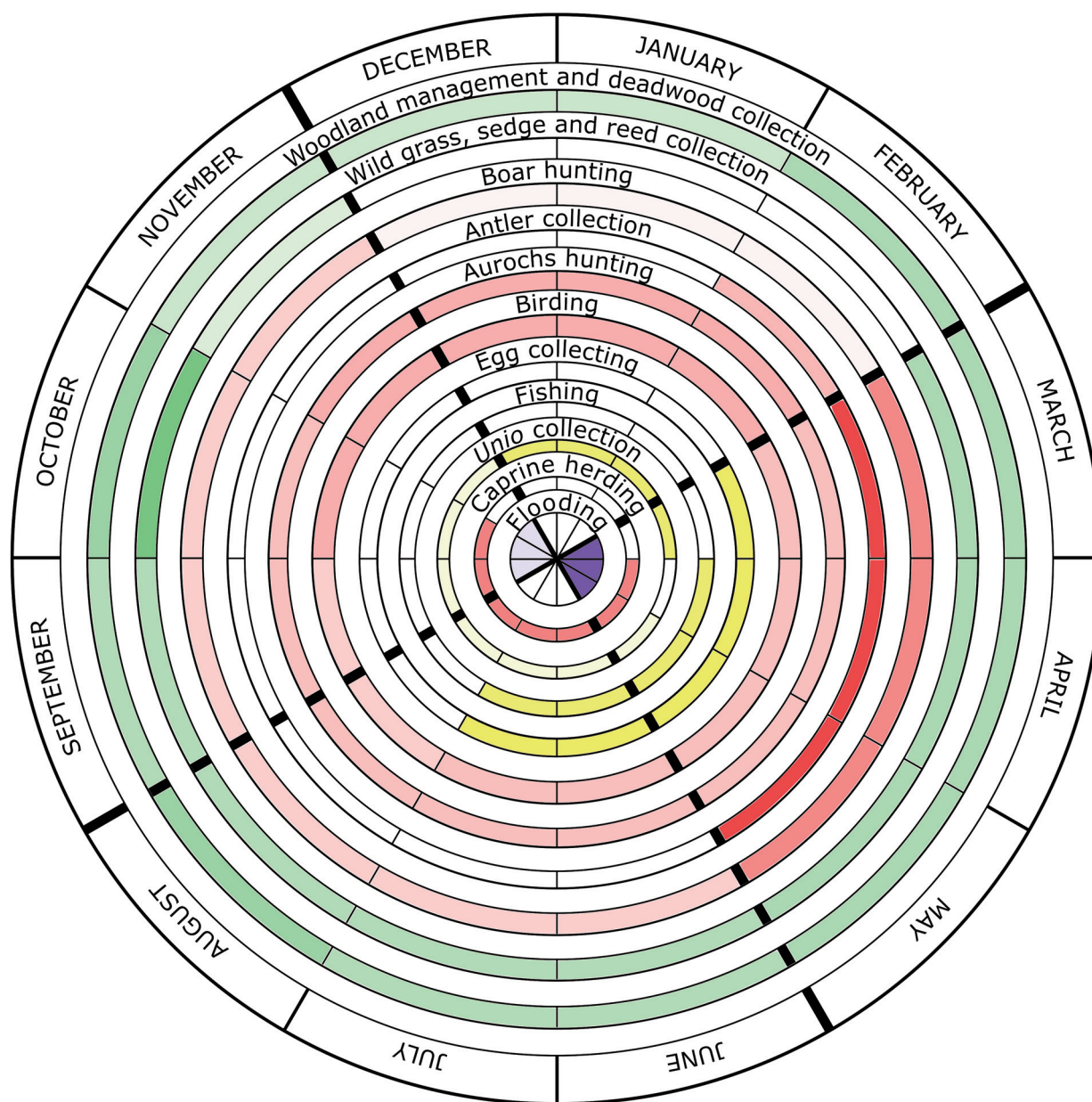


Figure 8.1. Chart of seasonal activities in wetland and riparian environments around Neolithic Çatalhöyük. Activities are grouped into thematically, with the flooding cycle (blue) separated from various animal-related tasks (red), tasks involving the collection of animals (yellow), and the collection of plants (green). White segments do not suggest that the activity positively did not occur in such periods, just that it would be less likely to have occurred.
