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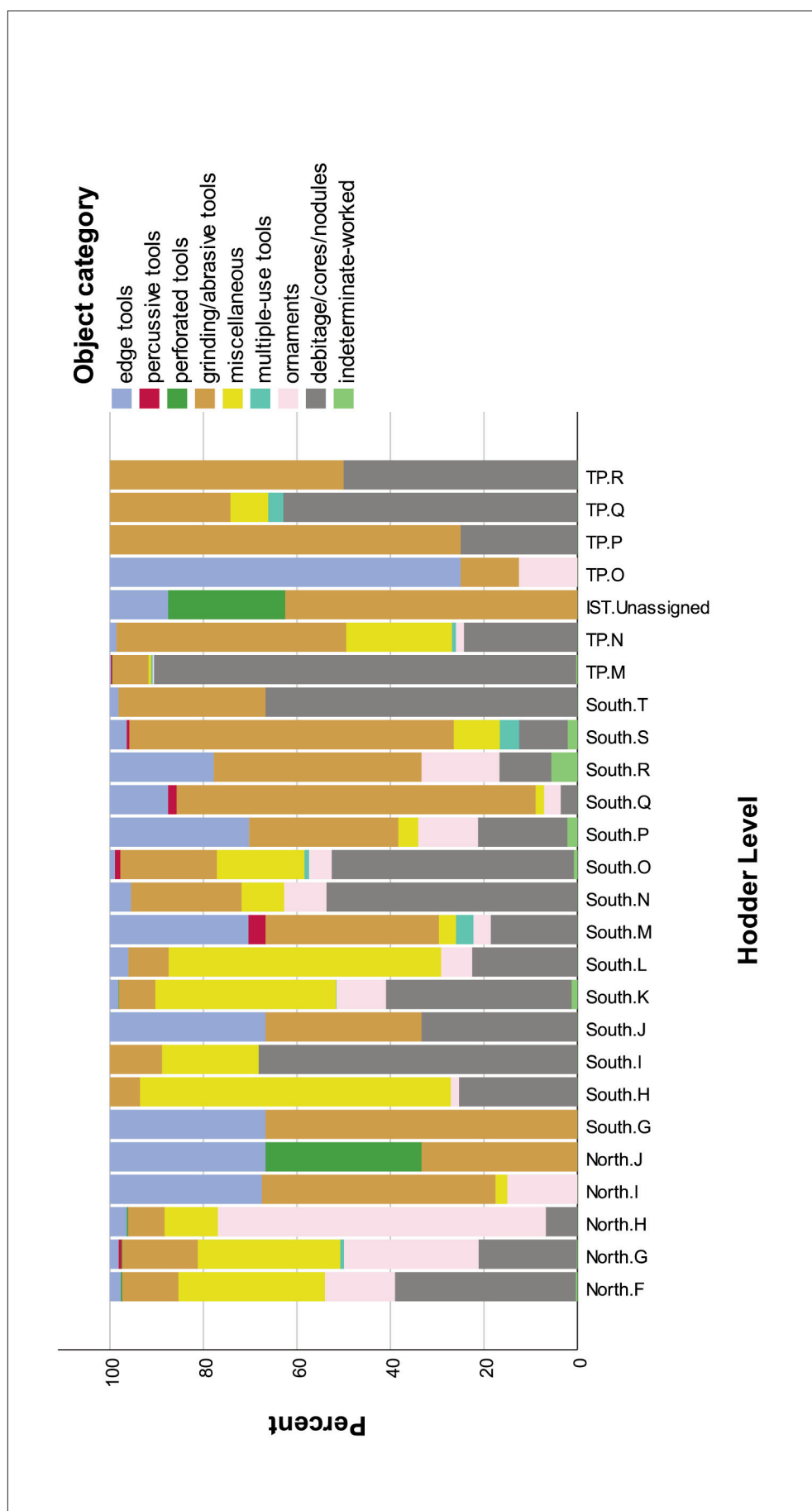


Figure S13.1. The temporal distribution of ground stone artefacts across Hodder Levels.

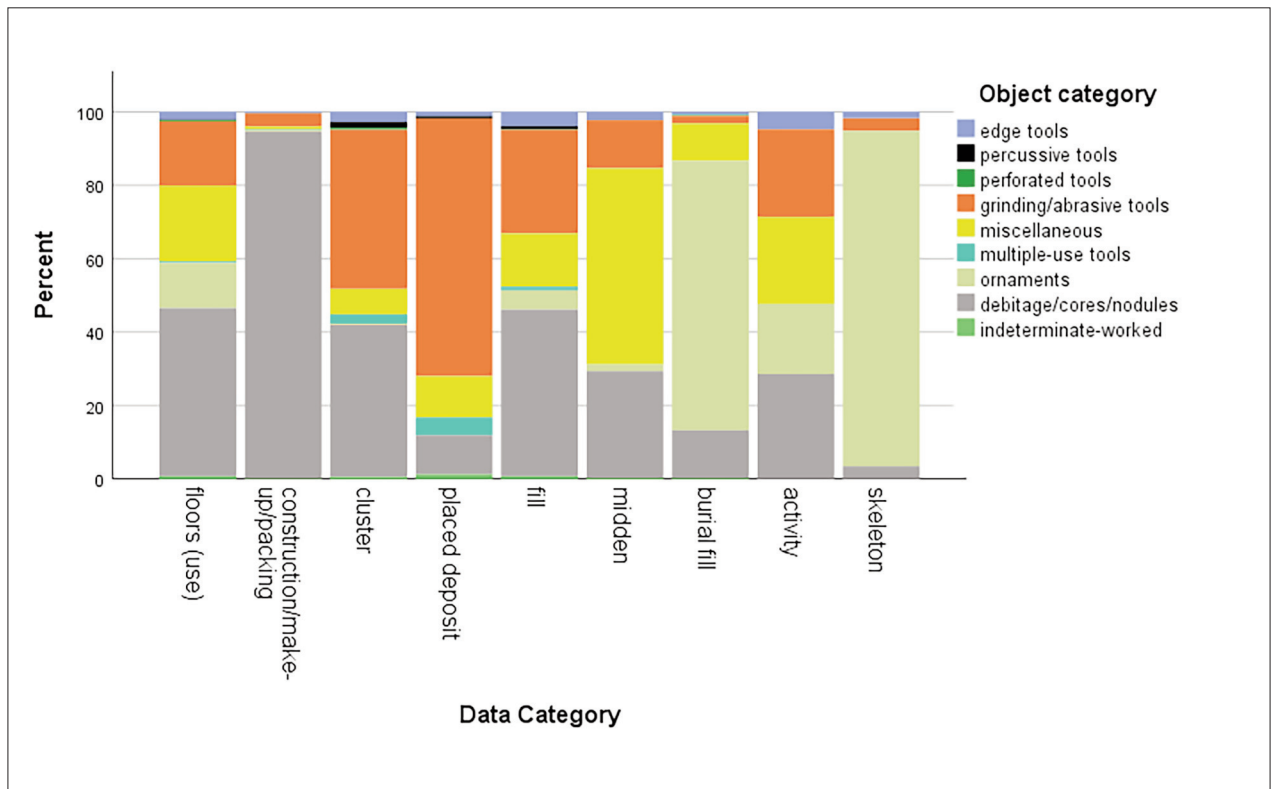


Figure S13.2. The distribution of ground stone objects across data categories.

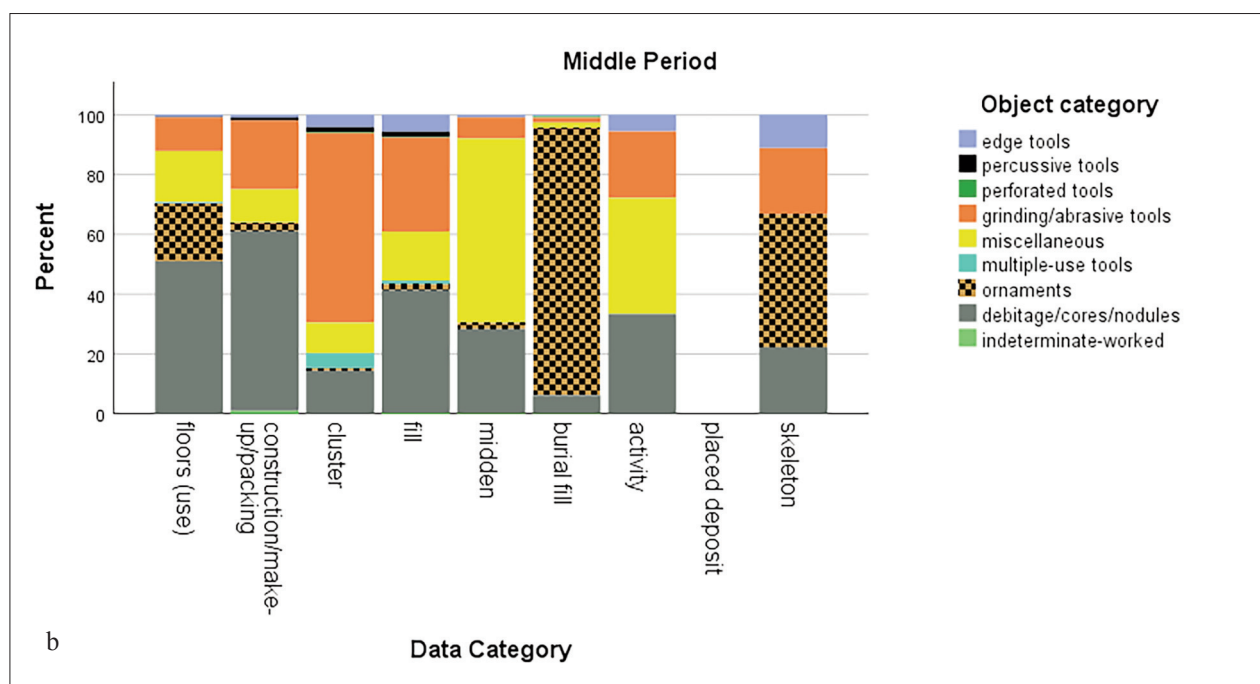
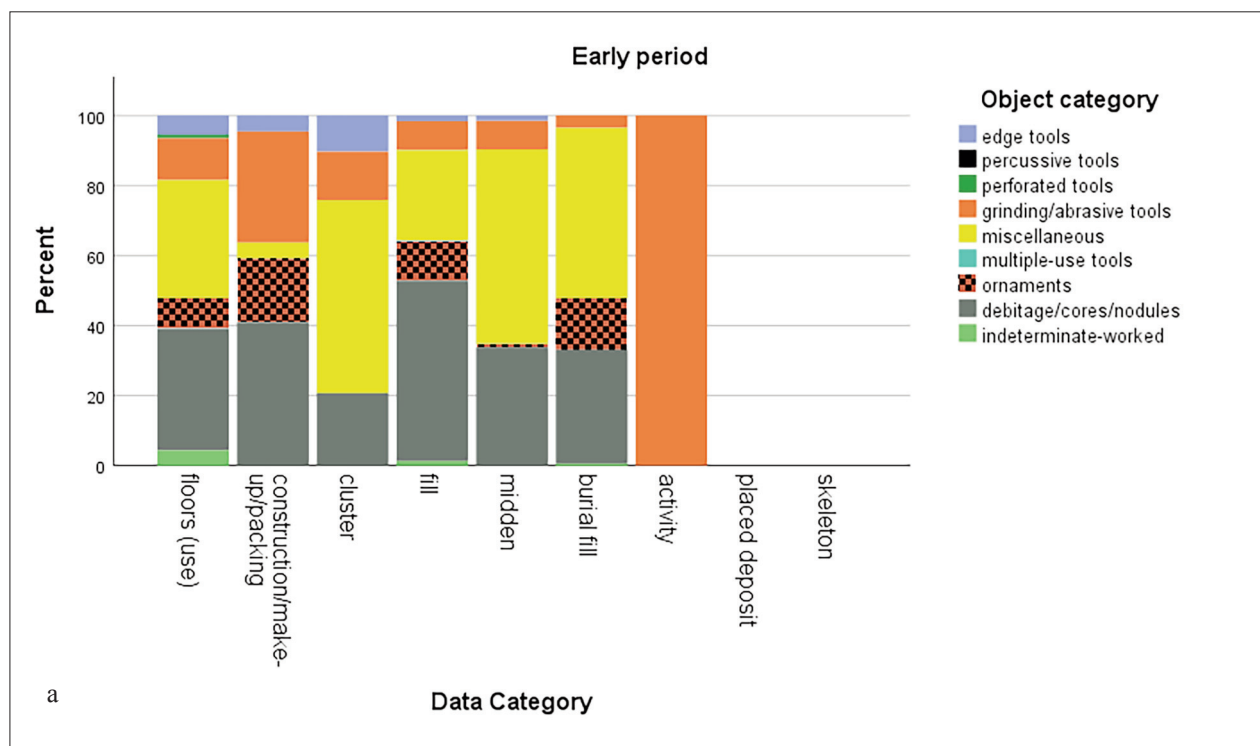


Figure S13.3a–b. The distribution of ground stone artefacts across data categories during the Early and Middle periods.

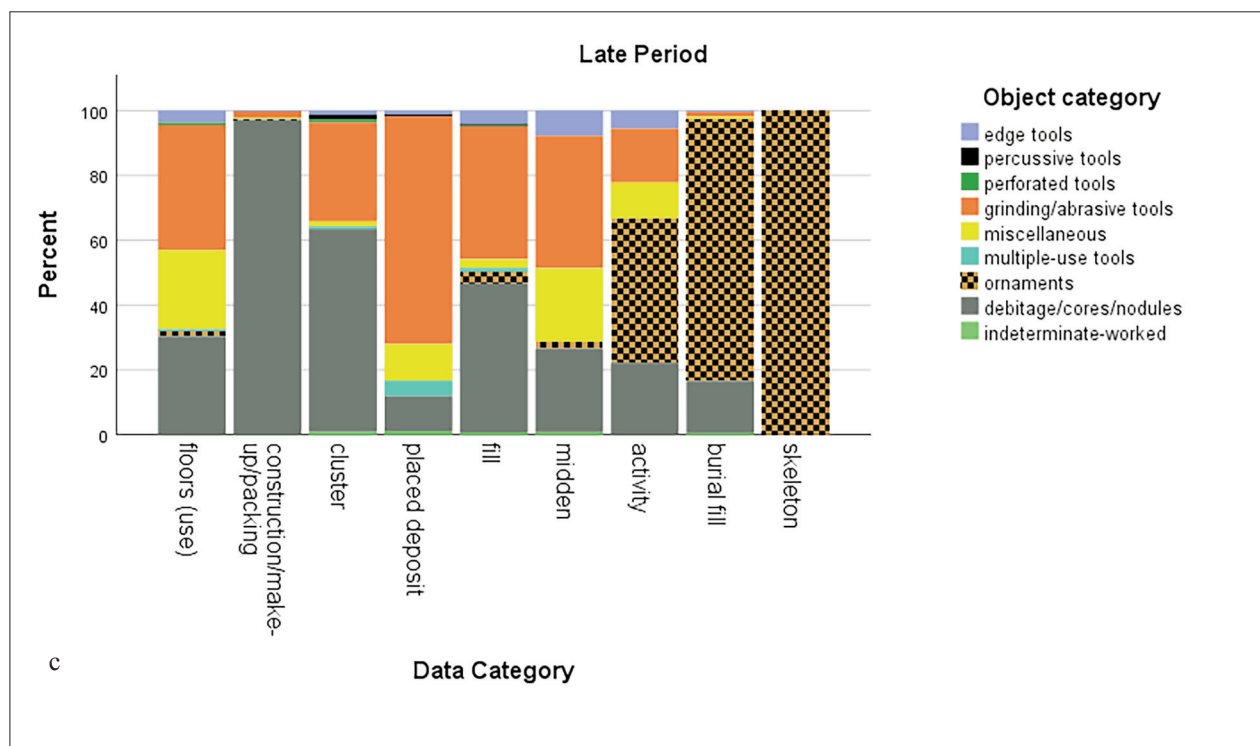


Figure S13.3c. The distribution of ground stone artefacts across data categories during the Late period.

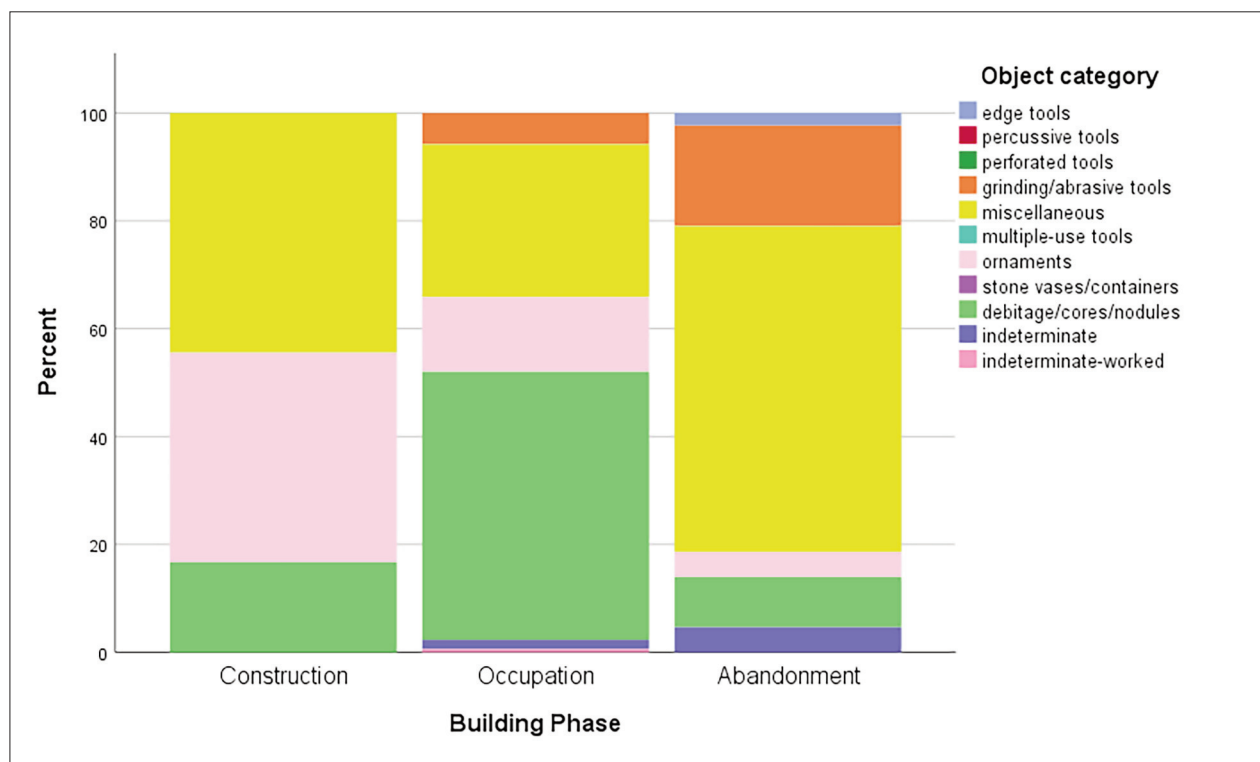


Figure S13.4. The distribution of ground stone artefacts across the building phases of B.132

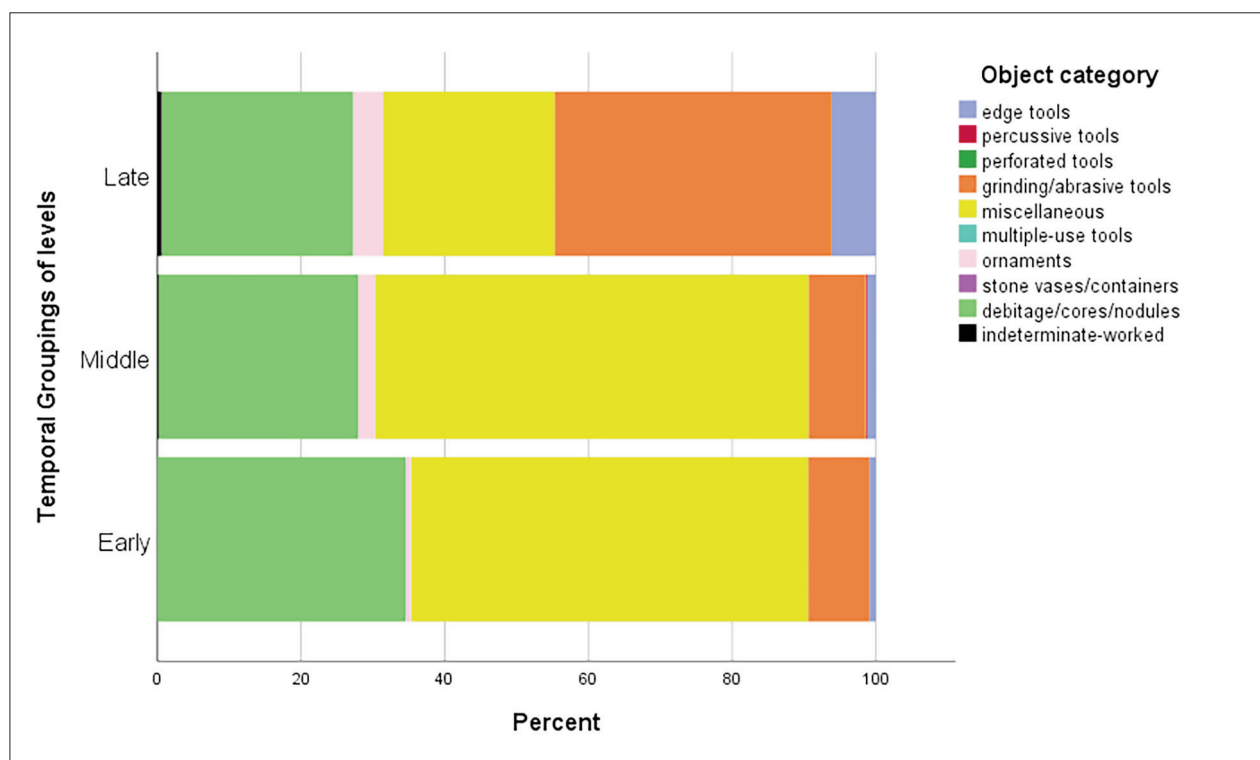


Figure S13.5. The temporal distribution of ground stone objects in open spaces (excluding indeterminate cases).

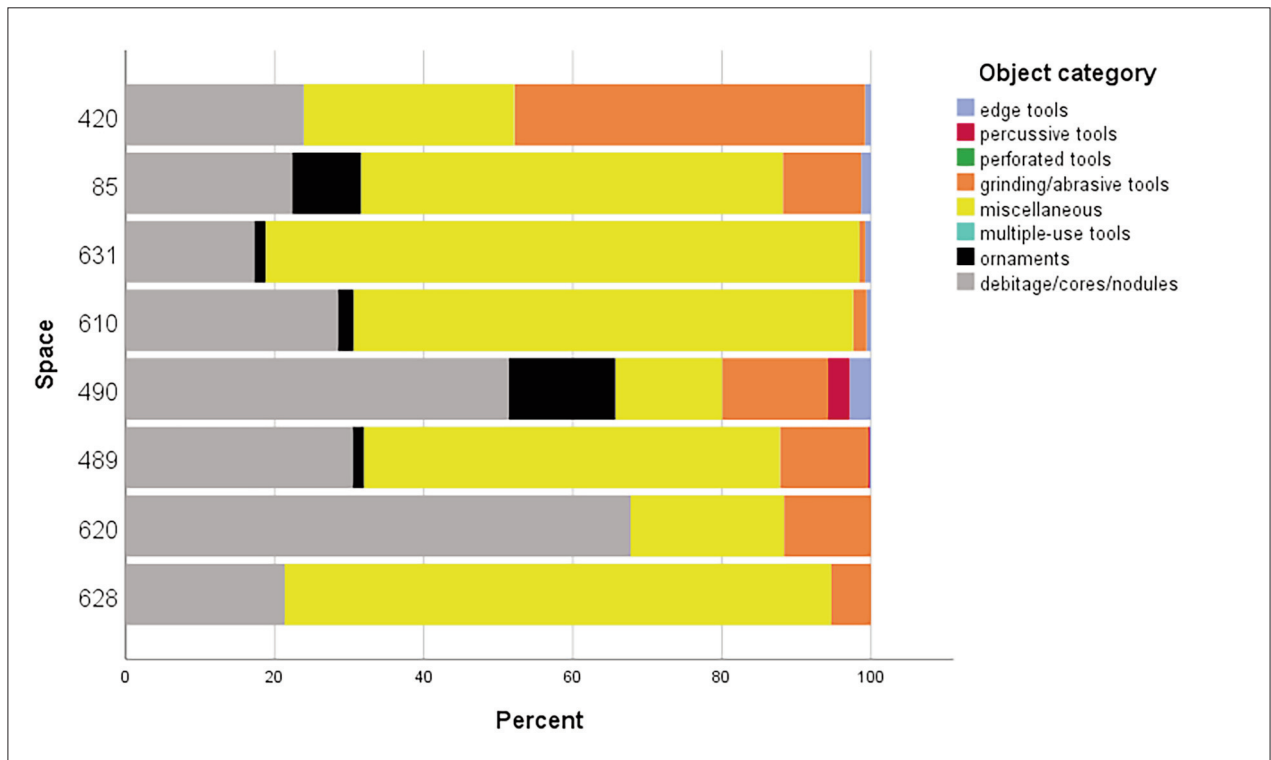


Figure S13.6. The distribution of ground stone objects in open areas excavated between 2009–2017.
