


Figure 15.18. Temporal distribution of burial deposition categories through major occupation periods at Çatalhöyük.




Figure 15.19. Comparison of age distributions of tertiary skeletal remains from internal and external spaces.




Figure 15.20. Bone representation index for internal and external space tertiary assemblage.




Figure 15.21. Proportion of 'headless' individuals, secondary and tertiary crania/mandibles across temporal periods at Çatalhöyük.




Figure 15.27. Spatial location of primary burials within houses by age category. Data presented for all occupation phases, including construction and abandonment.




Figure 15.28. Spatial location of secondary burials within houses by age category. Data presented for all occupation phases, including construction and abandonment.




Figure 15.29. Proportion of primary and secondary burials during house occupation phases.




Figure 15.30. Age breakdown of primary burials within houses by occupation phase.




Figure 15.31. Age breakdown of secondary burials within houses by occupation phase.




Figure 15.32. Proportion of foundation/construction burials per total number of individuals by age category for the Early, Middle, Late and Final period primary and secondary burials.




Figure 15.33. Age distribution of foundation/construction burials for Early, Middle and Late period primary and secondary burials.




Figure 15.34. Skeletal orientation (head placement) of Çatalhöyük primary burials ($N=330$), all occupation periods combined.




Figure 15.35. Skeletal orientation (head placement) of Çatalhöyük primary burials across temporal periods.
